## Protect Our Jobs!



An estimated 1,880,000 American workers are displaced from their jobs every year by immigration; the cost for providing welfare and assistance to these Americans is over \$15 billion a year. Thev collect government services. even social security!

The effect of immigration on those low-skilled Americans is profound, and the government knows it: "Undoubtedly access to lower-wage foreign workers has a depressing effect [on wages]," says former Labor Secretary Robert Reich. Research suggests that between 40 and 50 percent of wage-loss among low-skilled Americans is due to the immigration of low-skilled workers. Some native workers lose not just wages but their jobs through immigrant competition. However, not only the unskilled are in jeopardy. OTR drivers, nurses and health care professionals of all specialties, tech workers, and welders are just some of the skilled sectors that are seeing a boom in mostly non-white immigrant employees.
